The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) will hold a virtual Information Session to share updates on the upcoming Medicaid benefit for 1115 Waiver Housing Services. This event will provide an opportunity for organizations to learn how to begin preparing to seek reimbursement for these essential services.

The 1115 Waiver grants HFS flexibility to implement innovative services that address Health Related Social Needs (HRSN). This Information Session will provide an overview of the HRSN Housing benefit, share what to expect for provider enrollment, and discuss how organizations may prepare for the next phase of this important statewide initiative.

This virtual town hall is meant for organizations who intend to enroll as a Medicaid provider and receive reimbursement for housing services provided under the Healthcare Transformation 1115 Waiver. The intended audience is staff who will be responsible for business processes associated with Medicaid enrollment.
