## PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse physicians employed by a state medical school. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after April 19, 2025.

The Department is proposing to submit a state plan amendment to update language outlining the rate methodology for services provided by physicians employed by a state medical school. This is not a change in rate development methodology or rates, but rather a change in the process of paying the claims and clarifies that the state fee schedule rate for these physician services is their average commercial rate (ACR).

This proposed change is anticipated to be budget neutral. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
