PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse hospital providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2026.

The Department is proposing to reimburse hospitals for high-cost drugs that cost more than \$1,000,000 outside their bundled payment rate methodology. Hospitals will submit claims for high-cost drugs separately and be reimbursed for these drugs consistent with existing reimbursement methodologies for physician administered drugs.

This proposed change is anticipated to produce a net increase of \$10 million for services provided through fee-for-service or through managed care organizations. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
