PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing changes in the methods and standards of payment to providers to be compliant with the federal requirements. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after March 1, 2025.

The Department is proposing to submit a state plan amendment to clarify Illinois' compliance with federal requirements as they relate to transportation services. As described in regulations at 42 C.F.R. § 440.170(a), transportation includes travel related expenses determined to be necessary by the Medicaid agency to secure covered services. Related travel expenses may include the cost of meals, lodging, and costs that may be incurred by non-employee attendants accompanying patients in long-distance transportation. Reimbursement rates for necessary food and lodging are established by the federal government's General Services Administration.

This proposed change is anticipated to increase expenditures by \$2.2 million annually for services provided through fee-for-service or through managed care organizations. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
