## Public Comment Notice – Proposed 1915(i) State Plan Amendment Pediatric Palliative Care Program

January 19, 2023

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) proposes to submit a 1915(i) state plan amendment (SPA) to establish a new home and community-based services (HCBS) benefit.

Pursuant to <u>Public Act 102-0655</u>, the 1915(i) SPA will establish the Illinois Pediatric Palliative Care Program (PPCP). Under the PPCP, new home and community-based pediatric palliative services will be available within the Illinois Medicaid program. The PPCP benefit is targeted to children under the age of 21 diagnosed with a life-threatening or life-limiting condition who meet established needs-based criteria.

Children eligible for the PPCP will have access to the following services:

- Pain and symptom management;
- Expressive therapies;
- Therapeutic serious illness and bereavement support; and,
- Respite care.

This expanded service array will provide additional support to families in managing their child's symptoms in the home setting, with a focus on improving childhood quality of life. HFS anticipates implementing these new services effective July 1, 2023. The fiscal impact for the PPCP is estimated at \$1.3 million annually.
