 - HB 4133 Provides that a biological father of a child has a duty to pay 50% of the mother's pregnancy expenses
 - HB 4405 would allow people to pause their UIB while engaging in temp employment
 - HB 4423 and SB 3123 proposes to increase TANF grant amounts and end of pass-through requirements
 - HB 4451 – Provides that inmates must be paid a prevailing wage if their labor is used to remodel or rehabilitate correctional facilities
