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Public Comment Notice - Home and Community Based Services Waiver

2/20/2025

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) proposes to amend the Home and Community Based Services Waiver (HCBS) for the Persons with Brain Injury – IL 0329. This amendment will be effective 7/1/2025. Changes in the amendment include:

- 1. Individual Provider (IP) rate increases;
- 2. Update the Service Cost Maximum (SCM);
- 3. Revise the procedure for establishing the exceptional care rate;
- 4. Change the purchase limits for Environmental Accessibility Adaptations and Specialized Medical Equipment and Supplies from \$25,000 every five (5) years; to \$26,300 every three (3) years; and
- 5. Reduce the number of required bids for Environmental Mods from three (3) to two (2).

HFS seeks public input on this proposed waiver amendment through two separate statements of public notice.
