PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates for Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs). The proposed change is effective for dates of service on and after January 1, 2021 and is addressed below.

Effective January 1, 2021, and in subsequent years, based on specific appropriation, the Prospective Payment System rates for FQHCs shall be increased by a uniform percentage calculated to spend the specific appropriation of \$25 million in state fiscal year 2021. This will provide rate increases to the medical, dental, and behavioral health encounter rates.

This proposed change will result in an annual increase in Medicaid liability of approximately \$50 million.
