Consultation

Most women with peripartum depression see primary care health providers. It is difficult for many women to access mental health providers. Frequent barriers include lack of sufficient mental health resources in some areas, lack of funds, and stigma of attending a mental health clinic.

Illinois has launched a statewide effort to improve care for women with peripartum depression. As part of this initiative, primary care providers can receive consultation, free of charge, from experts in women's mental health regarding care of patients with peripartum depression. In many cases, with consultation, providers can treat patients' depression in the primary care setting.

<u>Referral</u>

Sometimes providers should refer women to mental health professionals. Examples of such situations are:

- The patient has serious thoughts of suicide
- The patient has symptoms of mania or hypomania
- The patient has not improved with 4 6 weeks of treatment with a therapeutic dose of antidepressant medication
