PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

This Notice provides clarification to the original <u>Public Notice</u> issued June 7, 2018, regarding a proposed change in the methods and standards of payment to hospital providers.

The Department plans to submit an administrative state plan update revising the language to accurately reflect the reimbursement for outpatient services provided at critical access hospitals to a 23% increase over reimbursement levels prior to 7/1/18, as intended and presented in financials for state plan amendment 18-0005. One-time supplemental payments will be issued to critical access hospitals to bring reimbursement to the intended levels for claims that were originally underpaid.
