## PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

## STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the inpatient and outpatient grouper versions. The proposed change is effective for dates of service July 1, 2019, and after.

Effective with inpatient discharge dates beginning July 1, 2019, the Department will utilize Grouper Version 36 of the 3M All Patient Refined Diagnosis Related Group (APR-DRG) payment system.

Effective with outpatient dates of service beginning July 1, 2019, the Department will utilize Grouper Version 3.13 of the Enhanced Ambulatory Patient Groups (EAPG) payment system.

The payments apply to the inpatient and outpatient benefit categories. These proposed changes are estimated to be budget neutral.
