## PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

## STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates for providers of mental health services. The proposed change is effective for dates of service July 1, 2020 and after.

The proposed change provides for an increase in Medicaid reimbursement rates. The rate in effect on June 30, 2020 will increase by 2% effective July 1, 2020.

This proposed change will result in an annual increase in Medicaid liability of \$1.6 million based on the current utilization patterns for mental health rehabilitative services provided by a community mental health provider.
