PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates for the Department of Human Services' Division of Substance Use Prevention and Recovery providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service July 1, 2020 and after.

The proposed change provides for an increase in the Medicaid and non-Medicaid reimbursement rates. The rate in effect on June 30, 2020 will increase by 2% effective July 1, 2020.

This proposed change will result in an annual increase in Medicaid liability of \$365,000 based on the current utilization patterns for rehabilitative services provided by an alcohol or substance abuse provider.
