PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates for the Division of Substance Use Prevention and Recovery providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service July 1, 2019 and after.

<u>Public Act 101-0007</u> provides for an increase in the Medicaid and non-Medicaid reimbursement rates. The rate in effect on June 30, 2019 will increase by 2.5% effective July 1, 2019.

These proposed changes will increase expenditures by approximately \$375,000 based on current utilization patterns for rehabilitative services provided in or by an alcohol or substance abuse provider.
