- 2. <u>Summary of information</u>: The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services wishes to provide public notice regarding proposed changes in methods and standards for setting hospital rates. The Department may amend the Title XIX State plan to implement new hospital payment methodologies that would be funded by an assessment on hospital services. Amending the State plan to implement these new methodologies is dependent on the outcome of other pending rate changes or state initiatives.

The annual spending for these changes is estimated to be \$400 million.
