The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after September 1, 2016 and is addressed below.

- A newly approved waiver service, called Short-term Stabilization Homes, will begin on September 1, 2016. These homes, although licensed as a Community Integrated Living Arrangement, will be funded with an alternate methodology. These Short-term Stabilization Homes will be paid one twelfth of their annual negotiated contract per month following receipt and acceptance of required service reporting.
- Annual expenditures are expected to be \$4.8 million.
