Re: EVV December 2024 Updates

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) has outlined the most up-to-date information for State-wide EVV Aggregation below:

I. Timelines for EVV Implementation

- Personal Support Worker (PSW) agencies billing IDHS-DDD are required to either use HHA directly for EVV or transmit EVV from a third-party EVV system to HHAeXchange (HHA) for aggregation.
- Home Health Care Services (HHCS) provider agencies billing DSCC, IDHS-DDD, feefor-service Medicaid, HCI MCOs, or MMAI MCOs are also required to use HHA directly for EVV or transmit EVV from a third-party EVV system to HHA for aggregation.
- A date for Illinois Department on Aging's (IDoA's) Community Care Program (CCP)
 EVV aggregation with HHA has not yet been determined. In-home (Homemaker)
 provider agencies billing IDoA or MCOs (S5130) for service provision to CCP
 customers will be notified when a date for aggregation of IDoA EVV data with HHA
 has been established. Until this time, IDoA CCP providers should continue with
 business as usual. Providers with questions regarding IDoA EVV policy should reach
 out to IDoA's EVV inbox.
- A date for Illinois Department of Human Services—Division of Rehabilitation Services'
 (IDHS-DRS') Home Services Program (HSP) EVV aggregation with HHA has not yet
 been determined. In-home (Homemaker) and HHCS provider agencies billing IDHSDRS or MCOs (S5130) for service provision to HSP customers will be notified when a
 date for aggregation of DRS EVV data with HHA has been established. Providers with


II. Compliance Expectations

- The HFS EVV Policy for HHCS providers billing fee-for-service Medicaid, HCI MCOs, and MMAI MCOs has been updated and can be accessed at <u>HFS' EVV website</u>. The EVV policies for <u>DSCC</u> and <u>IDHS-DDD</u> can be found on each of their public facing websites.
- IDHS-DDD, DSCC, and HFS provider agencies who do not achieve 75% overall visit compliance by October 31, 2025, will receive Corrective Action Plans that if not implemented, will ultimately result in a referral to HFS OIG; Beginning **November 15, 2024:** "Know Your Numbers" is a tool that will auto generate from HHA as a monthly report to each provider agency having a portal within the IL HHA EVV system, regardless of whether a provider agency is using HHA directly for EVV or using a third-party system to collect and aggregate EVV with HHA. On the 15th of every month, each provider agency will receive via email a report showing EVV compliance information for the month prior. For this report to generate an accurate picture of the prior month, all provider agencies need to ensure all EVV data for the prior month are entered and aggregated within HHA in as close to real-time as possible and no later than the 10th of the month. Agencies need to ensure their contact information within HHA is up to date to ensure reports are emailed to the appropriate contact(s). The first report should have been received by each provider agency on or shortly after November 15, 2024;
- The deadline for tracking full caregiver SSNs was October 17, 2024, as reflected in HFS' July 26, 2024, Provider Notice and covered during the Illinois EVV Townhall webinars. You can also review HHA's Caregiver SSN Requirements for guidance. This is applicable to agencies using the HHAeXchange solution and agencies transmitting to HHAeXchange from third-party EVV systems as:
 - Agencies using the HHAeXchange solution will need to update caregiver profiles within the HHAeXchange system.
 - Agencies using third-party EVV systems must update existing caregiver profiles to include a valid nine-digit SSN via the Application.

III. Technical Assistance

Providers that are currently required to use HHA or transmit EVV data to HHA for aggregation should follow the below approach for technical assistance:

- First review HHA's Learning Management System (LMS) and/or <u>HHA's Illinois</u> <u>Information website;</u>
- Providers might also review EVV FAQ and Illinois EVV Townhall webinar materials on HFS' EVV website;
- If providers are unable to resolve technical concerns through review of HHA
 resources, they may submit their concerns to HHA via the Illinois EVV Helpline at
 1-833-961-7429, the <u>Illinois email support address</u>, or through visiting the HHA
 <u>Client Support portal;</u>
- Please note that use of the Client Support portal is the ideal method for
 obtaining assistance from HHA. Provider agencies need to access the Client
 Support portal directly to view and send responses to messages from HHA. It is
 the provider agency's responsibility to respond to questions and follow up from
 HHA via the Client Support portal within a couple of business days to avoid
 closure of Client Support portal tickets prior to resolution. To avoid
 premature ticket closure, provider agency representatives who anticipate barriers
 to responding to feedback from HHA within a couple of business days are
 encouraged to add contact information for multiple provider agency staff to
 tickets;
- In instances where provider agencies have not received initial response from HHA
 within two business days of submitting a concern to the Client Support portal or
 have not received the level of guidance needed for resolution within one
 business week, provider agencies may escalate their concerns to the respective
 state payer's EVV inbox:
 - <u>EVV inbox for HHCS provider agencies billing fee-for-service</u>
 <u>Medicaid and/or MCOs</u>
 - <u>EVV inbox for HHCS provider agencies billing DSCC</u>
 - EVV inbox for PSW and HHCS provider agencies billing IDHS-DDD
- Providers may add an above EVV inbox to HHA support tickets by either carbon copying the respective EVV inbox when emailing HHA's <u>Illinois email support</u> <u>address</u>, or by adding an EVV inbox as a "participant" to a ticket after creating the ticket within <u>HHA's Client Support portal</u>.
