

**PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS  
FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES**

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department reimburses providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after April 1, 2019 and is addressed below.

The Department is delaying the implementation of the Integrated Health Home (IHH) program which is the fully integrated care coordination program for the physical health, behavioral health and social care needs of eligible participants in the Illinois Medical Assistance Program. The Department has determined that more time is necessary to educate providers and the public about IHH services and the vision for this program.

The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.

Any interested party may submit questions or comments concerning these proposed changes in reimbursement methods and standards. All questions or comments must be submitted in writing within thirty (30) days of the publication date of this notice and addressed to:
