The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS), in conjunction with the Illinois Department of Human Services, Division of Rehabilitation Services (DHS-DRS), propose to renew the HCBS Waiver for Persons with Brain Injury. The proposed waiver renewal includes (1) changes necessary to comply with federal regulations, including modifications to the processes related to Participant Centered Planning (PCP) and inclusion of language described in the Illinois Statewide Transition Plan for Compliance with HCBS settings as required by CMS, (2) updated cost and participant estimates that reflect historical trends, including an additional subcategory of Overtime Nursing to account for Extended State Plan Services of Intermittent Nursing Services and overtime pay, (3) updated performance measures, and (4) revision of reassessment timeline from semi-annual reassessments to annual reassessments..

Illinois seeks public input into the development of the HCBS Waiver renewal for Persons with Brain Injury through two separate statements of public notice and input.
