## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this policy is to notify Care Coordination Units (CCUs) and Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) of policy changes related to the provision of case management services through contractual means with the MCOs.

## POLICY:

CCUs cannot enter into contracts with MCOs to provide case management services to MCO members in geographic service areas where they have CCU contracts to complete eligibility assessments with the Illinois Department on Aging. For purposes of this policy, case management services that are prohibited to be contracted with the MCOs include development of care plans, authorization or arrangement of services, direct referrals or any activity that directly impacts the plan of care. This policy does not preclude CCUs from entering into contracts with MCOs to provide assistance with locating participants or basic monitoring of participant's health within their own geographical service area. This policy also does not preclude CCUs from entering into contracts with the MCOs to provide <u>all</u> aspects of case management services in <u>other</u> geographical service areas or for members under the age of 60 <u>within</u> their own geographical service area.
