## **Additional Information**

- If an individual reports that they have private or other medical insurance, the provider will bill that entity first, before the HFS Family Planning Medicaid will kick in.
- Treatment for chronic diseases such as HIV/AIDs and hepatitis are NOT COVERED under the Family Planning Program.
- Gender Affirming Hormone Therapy (GAHT) is not covered under the Family Planning Program but would be covered under standard Medicaid for those who qualify.
- If a service is billed that isn't family planning specific, there must be a diagnosis to show that the service was family planning related for Medicaid to pay under this limited Medicaid coverage category.
