Excellent	The National Committee for Quality Assurance awards its highest accreditation status of Excellent for service and clinical quality that meet or exceed NCQA's rigorous requirements for consumer protection and quality improvement. <sup>1</sup> HEDIS® and <sup>2</sup> CAHPS® results are in the highest range of national performance.	
Commendable	NCQA awards an accreditation status of Commendable for service and clinical quality that meet NCQA's rigorous requirements for consumer protection and quality improvement.	
Accredited	NCQA awards an accreditation status of Accredited for service and clinical quality that meet the basic requirements of NCQA's rigorous standards for consumer protection and quality improvement.	
Provisional	NCQA awards a status of Provisional to organizations with programs for service and clinical quality that meet some basic requirements for consumer protection and quality improvement.	
Interim	NCQA awards a status of Interim to organizations with basic structure in place to meet expectations for consumer protection and quality improvement. Organizations awarded this status will need to undergo a new review within 18 months to demonstrate they have the executed those processes effectively.
