Welcome to HealthChoice Illinois — your way to quality Medicaid care!

You must enroll in a health plan in the HealthChoice Illinois Program. HealthChoice Illinois covers Medicaid services for individuals with both Medicare and Medicaid who live in a long term care (nursing home) or supportive living facility or receive services at home, such as aging or physically disabled waiver services.

Your new health plan will cover all the long term care or waiver services you get now. All health plans have care coordination to manage your healthcare, long term care and waiver services. You will keep getting all of your Medicare benefits the way you do now.

You must use long term care and waiver service providers that are in your health plan's network. If you use a Personal Assistant (PA) in your waiver services, they are accepted under all health plans' networks. Before enrolling, you should check to see what health plans your current providers accept.

After you are enrolled

Your health plan will mail you a Welcome Packet and ID card. You will use your member ID card to get long term care or waiver services. If you have questions, call your health plan's member services number on your member ID card and in the member handbook.

You can change your HealthChoice Illinois health plan anytime in the first 90 days. After that, you can change your health plan one time each year during the time called "open enrollment."

The Medicare-Medicaid Alignment Initiative (MMAI) program

Since you have both Medicare and Medicaid you can choose to enroll in the **Medicare-Medicaid Alignment Initiative** program instead of the HealthChoice Illinois program.

The MMAI program brings together all of your Medicare, Medicaid and prescription drug benefits into one health plan. Most MMAI plans also offer extra benefits such as more dental care and lower prescription co-pays. All health plans have care coordination to manage all of your healthcare services. To enroll in the MMAI program, you must choose a health plan and a primary care provider (PCP).

The MMAI health plans you can choose from are:

- Blue Cross Community MMAI
- Humana

- IlliniCare Health
- Meridian Complete
- Molina Healthcare

Not all plans are available in all counties.

You can enroll in the MMAI program at any time.
