## PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

## STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse providers. The proposed changes are effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2022.

The proposed changes medical forensic services to any sexual assault survivor be reimbursed at a rate of at least \$1,000 for examinations in a hospital or federally qualified health center.

The Department estimates this change will increase expenditures by approximately \$2,800,000 annually. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
