

**PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING  
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES**

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after May 1, 2025.

Pursuant to [410 ILCS 70/1](#), the Department is proposing to add coverage of medical forensic examinations provided to sexual assault survivors and delivered by pediatric health care facilities. Pediatric health care facilities are approved for participation by the Department of Public Health pursuant to [77 Ill. Adm. Code 545.62](#). Medical forensic examinations will be reimbursed at a \$1,000 per examination.

This proposed change is anticipated to be budget neutral. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.

Any interested party may submit questions or comments concerning these proposed changes in reimbursement methods and standards.
