## PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing changes in the methods and standards of payment to providers. The proposed changes become effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2025.

The Department is proposing to increase the services provided by practitioners at state owned medical schools that are eligible for enhanced rates at their Average Commercial Rate. The following are the increases in services:

- Inclusion of additional state-owned medical schools with affiliated hospitals in Illinois.
- Inclusion of affiliated providers in addition to employed providers.
- Inclusion of services provided by licensed practitioners other than physicians.

This proposed change will result in an estimated annual increase in Medicaid liability of \$85 million for services provided through fee-for-service or through managed care organizations. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
