Public Comment Notice - Home and Community Based Services Waiver

9/6/2024

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) proposes to amend the Home and Community Based Services Waiver (HCBS) for Adults with Developmental Disabilities – IL0350. Changes in the amendment include:

1. Adding a new Specialty Telehealth and Assessment Team service to the waiver.
2. Rate increases for the Community Day Services, Residential Habilitation, and Supported Employment.
3. Updates to Main B Optional and J-2-c-i due to character limits and to clean up language.

HFS seeks public input on this proposed waiver amendment through two separate statements of public notice.
