

**PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING  
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES**

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing changes in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2026.

Pursuant to [Public Act 103-1024](#), the Department is proposing to add coverage of mobile integrated health care services delivered by licensed emergency medical services (EMS) personnel. Covered services include health assessment, chronic disease monitoring and education, medication compliance, immunizations and vaccinations, laboratory specimen collection, hospital discharge follow-up care, and minor medical procedures as approved by applicable EMS Medical Director.

This proposed change is anticipated to reduce hospital emergency department visits, offsetting the cost of the new covered services and resulting in an assumed budget neutral fiscal impact. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
