PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS/Department) is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs). The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2024.

Pursuant to PA 103-0102, the Department is proposing to increase the Prospective Payment System (PPS) rates for FQHCs by 11%. The Department is also proposing to update the definition of behavioral health encounters to allow for billing of services rendered by a licensed clinical psychologist (LCP), a licensed clinical social worker (LCSW), a licensed clinical professional counselor (LCPC), a licensed marriage and family therapist (LMFT), or by a sub-clinical behavioral health professional operating under the direct supervision of a psychiatrist, nurse practitioner with a psychiatric specialty, LCP, LCSW, LCPC, or LMFT. A sub-clinical behavioral health professional is defined as an individual possessing a master's or doctoral degree in counseling and guidance, rehabilitation counseling, social work, psychology, pastoral counseling, marriage and family therapy, or related field.

The Department estimates this change will increase expenditures by \$60 million annually for services provided through fee-for-service or through managed care organizations. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
