## PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

## STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2017 and is addressed below.

As an ongoing effort to provide access to care and quality services, the Department is proposing to reimburse for Medication Assisted Treatment services. Providers will receive reimbursement for dispensing or administering opioid compounds as a medical adjunct to substance abuse treatment on a weekly per patient basis.

The proposed reimbursement rate will be \$70.00 per week. The reimbursement changes will apply to mental health rehabilitative services provided in or by an alcohol or substance abuse provider. These proposed changes will increase expenditures by approximately \$38 million based on current utilization patterns.

The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
