PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after October 1, 2021.

Pursuant to <u>PA 102-0043</u>, the Department is proposing to reinstate chiropractic services for adults provided by a chiropractic physician licensed under the Medical Practice Act of 1987 and acting within the scope of his or her license. Services would include chiropractic manipulative treatment to correct spinal subluxation.

The Department estimates this change will increase expenditures \$1.4 million annually. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
