PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

STATE OF ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards of payment to certified community mental health centers identified in Rule 132. The proposed change is effective for dates of service August 6, 2017, and after.

<u>Public Act 100-0023</u> requires the Division of Mental Health to develop an increased rate methodology for certified community mental health centers identified in Rule 132. The services subject to the increase include but are not limited to mental health assessment, psychological evaluations, medication management, psychotherapy, and counseling.

The reimbursement changes will apply to mental health rehabilitative services provided in or by a community mental health centers. These proposed changes will increase expenditures by approximately \$7 million based on current utilization patterns to the mental health rehabilitative services benefit category.
