The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is issuing a Request for Applications (RFA) to solicit applications from interested providers to operate a Medicaid Preventive Care and Education Organization (MPCEO).

HFS is tasked by state law with the establishment and implementation of a Managed Primary Care Demonstration Project outlined in Section 12-4.56 in Public Act 102-0699. The goal of the project is to increase ownership of Medicaid enrollees in their health and well-being through greater healthcare knowledge; increased access and utilization of preventive care services; and increased engagement with their Primary Care Providers (PCPs), other health care providers, and health plans.

An awardee cannot be a Managed Care Company contracted with the Department during the term of the contract to be awarded.

The initial award period will run through June 30, 2026. Additional award years are subject to appropriation.
