At the request of the HFS Director, the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services presents this monthly report to monitor the completion of Medicaid Redeterminations. There are an estimated total of <u>2,274,437</u> cases which comprised of an estimated <u>2,034,244</u> (including 'in-flight') individual customers that must go through the Medicaid redetermination process during the <u>12 Month PHE Unwinding Period</u>: June 2023 - May 2024. Consistent with reporting requirements to our federal CMS partners, this report will be presented by the 20th of each month and will reflect previous month's outcome data by case and individual.

October's Cohort was comprised of 297,235 individuals. In October:






69,248 (23%) lost coverage, and

At the time of this report, November and December Cohorts have been sent request for redetermination but have not been through terminal entry. This group is comprised of 558,940 total individuals.











% of Redetermination Status by Individual - October 2023



% of Redetermination Status by Individual - YTD




The data below represents the outcome of the October 2023 redeterminations, and illustrates the responses received during the original due date and the 30-day grace period flexibility that was provided to Illinois by federal CMS. The 30-day Grace Period Flexibility was implemented in June 2023 and will remain in place during the 12 Month PHE Unwinding Period: June 2023 - May 2024. This flexibility permits the delay of procedural terminations for one month (approx. 30 days) for customers who did not return their redetermination by their original due date.



The chart to the left, 'Individuals who Received 30 Day Extension by Month', demonstrates 78% of Individuals due for REDE in August responded timely.

22% of individuals due in September were given an additional 30-days to respond.




