Medical Providers:

Stay Connected to Medicaid!



Mandated provider revalidation will begin in **September, 2024**.

All providers will need to complete the IMPACT revalidation process to remain enrolled in Medicaid.

If you do not revalidate, you risk inactive status (termination) and can no longer receive payment.

- Revalidation notices will be sent in rolling stages, and regular every-five-year revalidation will be ongoing.
- Be on the lookout in your email inbox for revalidation materials.
- Make sure to discuss revalidation with your office support staff, especially those in billing who interact with HFS.

Currently enrolled Medicaid providers will receive **two email notifications**, the first notice **90 calendar days** before the Revalidation Cycle end date and the second **30 calendar days** prior.
